- RESPECT is committed to complying with The Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and has formally discussed and adopted the statement at a meeting of the Board.
- RESPECT will confirm its commitment to the principles set out in the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising with a statement to this effect in its next annual report.
- RESPECT has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising.
- RESPECT will regularly monitor compliance with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and compliance reports will be received regularly by the Board.
- RESPECT will consider the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising when planning all fundraising activity in the future.
- RESPECT provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- RESPECT will appoint a member of the Board and or a member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising.
- RESPECT ensures that all involved in fundraising are provided with information and training on the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and its implementation.
- RESPECT has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising. Feedback is recorded for review by the relevant staff member and governing body. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- RESPECT will prepare financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 and the charity regulator.
- RESPECT ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and comply with data protection requirements.
- RESPECT is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
